Dear Parents/Carers,

<u>P.E.</u>: On a Wednesday morning it is P.E. in the hall with Mrs Ridpath. Please can you make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothing - no skirts, dresses, tights or long flowing tops. Thank you.

<u>Earrings</u>: Please only wear small stud earrings and please do not wear them on a Wednesday for PE. Please cover earrings if they cannot be removed for PE. Thank you.
