




Can you help us?

Despite our first match day of the term away to Sandy Hill being postponed (now rescheduled for 4th Feb) because of the inclement weather conditions, we have had a busy second week of term.

Having won the Brannel cluster qualifier for indoor athletics in December, on Monday we took a team of year 5s and 6s to Tregorrick Park for the next round against all the Mid Cornwall cluster winners from St Austell, Bodmin and Newquay. This is now a developmental competition so we took a number of children who were representing the school for the first time in athletics and they were all fantastic - not only competing well but supporting each other and continuing the strong team ethos we have fostered over the last three years. Each child participated in two races and two field events in which they scored points for the team. I am delighted to say that overall we finished 2nd and as such have qualified for the county finals in April for the second year in a row. This is a tremendous achievement and we are so proud of all the children that contributed to this success.

Thursday saw a return to Par for the next round of cross country. As always, we took a large team of children from years 4 to 6 and despite the wind, mud and damp they performed brilliantly - with many setting personal bests - and really enjoyed themselves. A special mention to Libby and Hayden who both returned with medals for finishing second in their respective races.
