Mathematics

Multiplication and division – using known facts to multiply and divide larger numbers. Identifying factors, prime and multiples. Calculating square and cube numbers. We will also use a formal written method to multiply and divide larger numbers.

Geometry: position and direction - identify, describe and represent the position of a shape following a reflection or translation, using the appropriate language, and know that the shape has not changed
