

Mathematics (Year 5 in brackets)

Week 1: Interpreting different graphs.

Week 2: Adding 4-digit numbers (more than 4-digit numbers) using the column method.

Week 3: Subtracting 4-digit numbers (more than 4-digit numbers) using the column method.

Week 4: Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 (1000).

Week 5: Converting units of measure - Km/m, Kg/g, MI/l

PSHE

Dreams and Goals:

Students can talk about hopes and dreams and understand that sometimes hopes and dreams do not come true. Children will learn to reflect on the positive to overcome disappointment and set new goals and dreams. Finally, students will work out steps needed to achieve a goal and identify others contributions.

Literacy (Year 5 in brackets)

Class Text: War Horse

Learning how to write a historical fiction, followed up by writing discussion texts on whether animals should be used in war.

In addition, they will extend their understanding of food chains to more complex chains and food webs.
