I'd like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for your support over the last two terms. It has been a pleasure taking on the Head of School role.

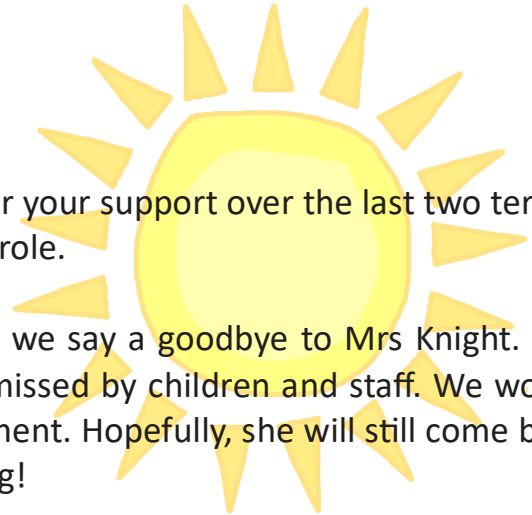
