Reading

- 3x a week recommended
- Bring reading books into school daily
- Children will have a book sent home linked to their Phonics level on a Monday and a Thursday. We encourage children to practise reading the same book during the week to develop fluency and understanding.
- We share the book in a phonics group daily.
- We also sharing a whole class reading text daily linked to our English text (from October half term) and a guided reading text.
- We will also be sharing book recommendations with the children and developing a love of reading through book talk, trips to the library and talking about authors and favourite books.


