

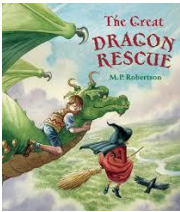
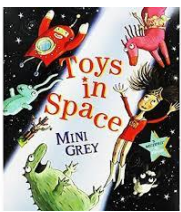


Year 2 Autumn Term 2 2025/2026 Home learning outcomes- Readymoney and Fistral

DT- Structures	
Investigating	Building

Play a game where you need to keep score. Draw a picture and record the scores.	Create a dance to your favourite song. Can you record it as a video? Can you teach someone else in your family?

Science - Animals and their habitats	
Knowledge	Investigations
Create a fact file about a habitat of your choice. Where is the habitat found? What lives there?	Find a micro-habitat in your garden or near where you live? Carry out a survey to see what animals live there. Can you encourage more animals to live there, especially during winter

Maths- Shape, Subtraction, Time and Multiplication
Recognise and name 2d and 3d shapes Practise drawing and solving 2-digit subtraction problems. Practise reading the time on analogue clocks using o'clock, quarter and half, then moving on to reading time to the nearest 5 mins. Count on and back in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Computing - Robot algorithms	
Have a go at some apps at home that require the input of instruction, eg Scratch, Daisy the Dinosaur, Lightbot	Use technology to present a piece of homework for another subject.

PSHE- Valuing Difference/Tolerance and Respect
