Maths-
Practise dividing in to equal groups with items found in the home. What different ways can you share 4, 8, 12, 15, 18?
Practise counting on in 2s, 5s and 10s.
Practise reading the time using o'clock, half and quarter past/to.

Computing – Computer systems and networks	
What pieces of Information Technology do you have at home? How are they similar/different? Do you use them? How/what for?	Use technology to present a piece of homework for another subject.

PSHE- Growing and Changing	
Create your own timeline from when you were born to you now. You might want to include photos and information about milestones (when you walked, any holidays, changes like moving house or a new family member).	Write about a fun surprise you were involved in.
