





## Year 2 Spring 2 2025/2026 Home learning outcomes- Readymoney and Fistral

Ball Skills: Feet	Health and Wellbeing
Practise dribbling a ball through obstacles.  Can you kick a ball to a family member or friend?	Can you find out about a famous sports person? What are they well known for?

Music	
Listen to your favourite song. What instruments can you hear? Make a poster about the song listing the instruments.	Make your own maracas using objects and materials at home. Try making 2 different ones to hear the different sounds.

RE-	
Why does Easter matter to Christians?	
Can you make an Easter Egg using religious symbols?	Can you tell a family member the Easter story? Draw your favourite part.

Science – Scientists and Inventors	
Knowledge	Investigations
Find out about a scientist or inventor- what work did they do? How does their work help us today?	Design your own invention- how could it help lives today?

Topic- Significant Explorers	
History	Geography
Find out about an explorer from the past. Where did they go? What did they discover?	Visit a new or favourite place in Cornwall- show it on a map and write a diary entry about your visit.

Maths- length and height, addition, subtraction, time
Measure the different heights in your family- who is the tallest? Practise counting on and back in 2s, 5s and 10s. Recall a range of facts at home, included doubles, near doubles and adding and subtracting .

Computing – Making music	
Explore apps that make music. Can you record it and share with us in school?	Use technology to present a piece of homework for another subject.
