





# Crantock Summer Term 1 Home Learning Outcomes



Art	
Mixed Media Picasso & Collage	
<b>Picasso Texture Hunt</b>	<b>Composition Planner</b>
Find three different materials at home (like foil or newspaper) and layer them to create a cubist-style face.	Sketch a portrait and label where you would use "rough" and "smooth" textures to create contrast

Create a periscope using cardboard tubes and mirrors to demonstrate how light travels in straight lines and reflects.	Design a fact book or poster explaining how light travels and how our eyes see objects.

Athletics	
<b>Speed and Agility</b>	<b>Distance throwing</b>
Create a ladder on the ground using masking tape or ropes to practice quick footwork, focusing on high knees and agility.	Use rolled-up socks, tennis balls, or frisbees to measure throwing distance using a tape measure. How far can you throw?

<b>The Modern Vase</b>	<b>Olympic Origins</b>
Design a "Greek-style" pot showing a scene from your life today to act as evidence for future historians	Research one modern Olympic event and write one sentence explaining how it has changed since the first Greek games
