PE	
Locomotion- Dodging	Gymnastics- Pathways
Practise a sport or activity that requires you to dodge. Tell us about the rules of the game.	Create a sequence of moves at home- take a photo or video to share with us.

Music
Exploring Improvisation
Choose a song / nursery rhyme. Can you change the lyrics to improvise your own version. Write the new lyrics to share.

RE- Muslim	
Design and make a Muslim prayer mat.	Create a poster about the 5 pillars of Islam.

Science – Plants	
Draw and label a picture of a plant.	Look after a plant at home. Create a plant diary- you may want to take photographs or draw pictures

Topic- Geography	
Create a poster to explain what is Fairtrade and include Fairtrade items.	Use a map to locate and label Fairtrade countries.

Maths- Time, Multiplication and Divison, Money, Mass, Capacity and Measure
Practise counting on and back in 2, 5 and 10. Read the time to the nearest 5 minutes on analogue clocks. Use money to buy things, counting different coins. Have a go at measuring things, perhaps when helping with a cooking task.
