## PSHE

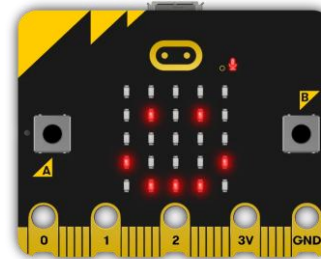
### Rights & Respect
