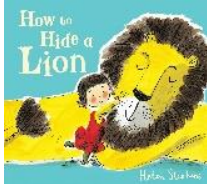
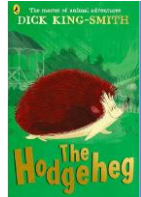
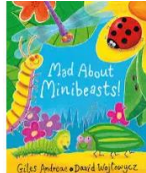




Year 2 Autumn Term 1 2026/2027 Home learning outcomes- Fistril
