Reading

- Minimum x3 a week recommended.

- Children will have a book sent home linked to their Phonics level on a Monday and a Thursday. We encourage children to practise reading the same book during the week to develop fluency and understanding.
- Next steps- Fluency books then Accelerated Reader.
- We will also be reading a class book daily developing a love of reading.
- Library book and visits to the library (Thursdays)
