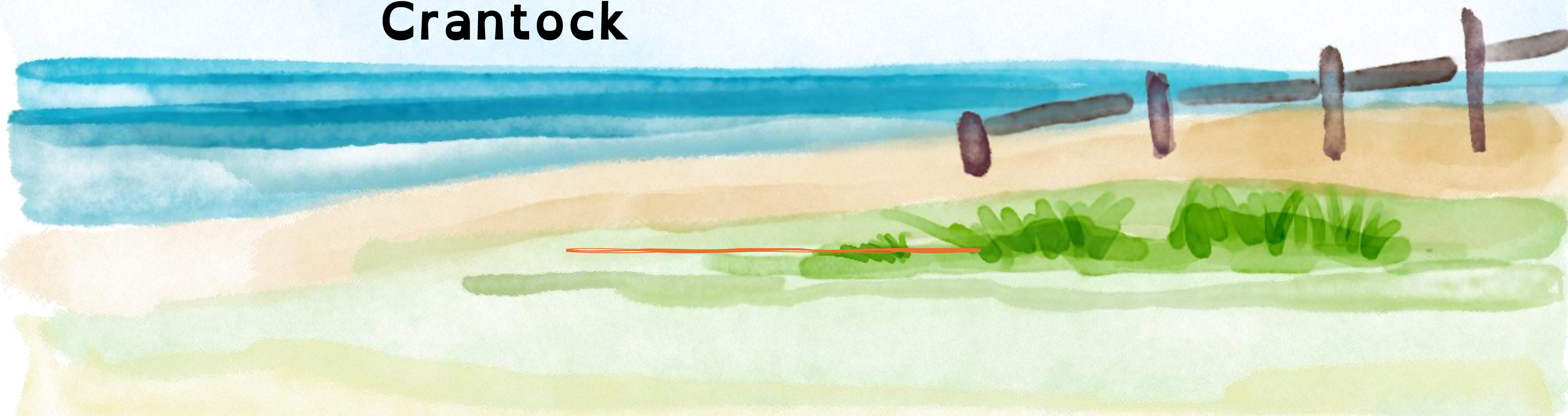

FAQs
