## PSHE:

## Me and My Relationships

Children will begin their year discussing classroom rules and why they are in place. They will then move on to recognising and exploring their feelings and how other people might be feeling based on their body language and reactions, who to speak to when they are upset and how to regulate their own emotions. Finally, students will identify the qualities of a good friend and how to resolve conflict situations through positive feedback and good listening

## Literacy

Class Texts: Super Duper You, Five Minutes Peace, The Great Big Book of Families, Knuffle Bunny and various poems inspired by the senses.

They will engage in a variety of investigations using their senses as a guide to conduct their experiments. They will learn which body part is associated with which sense. Finally, they will finish the term looking at the seasons, starting with the Autumn.
