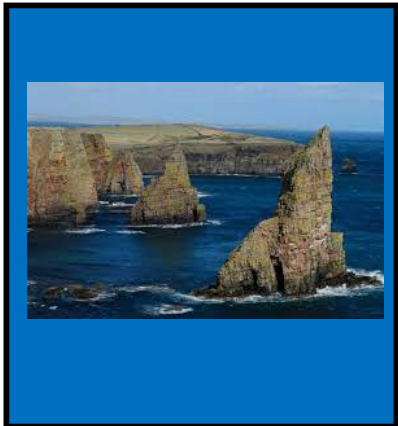
Science
